

Your IPS Spray Foam Insulation Checklist

Use this checklist to determine if it's time for an insulation upgrade!

Inspect Your Home for These Signs:

Indoor Temperature Issues:

- The house feels unusually warm, even with the AC on.
- Certain rooms are much hotter or colder than others.
- The temperature fluctuates drastically throughout the day.

High Energy Bills:

- My energy bills have increased without a clear reason.
- Comparing bills from the past few months shows a rising trend.

Drafts and Air Leaks:

- I can feel drafts near windows, doors, or attic spaces.
- Cold air seems to be escaping in the summer, or cold drafts are coming in during the winter.

Wall and Floor Temperature:

- Walls, floors, or ceilings feel cold to the touch in winter.
- The ceiling feels warm on a sunny day, indicating heat penetration.

Noise Levels:

- Outdoor noise seems louder inside, indicating poor insulation as a sound barrier.
- The noise level varies significantly between rooms.

Moisture and Mold:

- There are signs of moisture or water damage in the attic or walls.
- Mold or mildew is present in typically insulated areas.

Insects and Rodents:

- There are signs of pests in the attic or other areas that should be sealed off.

Old or Compressed Insulation:

- The existing insulation material is old, damaged, or has compressed over time, reducing its effectiveness.
